ADMISSION CRITERIA

- Admission to the Institute is strictly on merit as determined through an internal aptitude test of TIP and interview.
- Successful candidates passing the aptitude test will only qualify for the interview.
- Candidates passing the interview will then be short listed for admission at TIP.
- The merit list of candidates passing the interview will be based on the marks obtained in the admission test.
- A candidate must pass both the TIP's aptitude test and interview to get admission at TIP.

NOTE

- The decision of Admission Committee will be final and binding to all the candidates.
- Any external pressure / recommendation will disqualify the candidate.

GUIDELINES FOR CANDIDATES

- The admission test consists of multiple-choice questions and is in English. It is designed to recall factual information, application of knowledge and problem solving ability.
- The subject matter used for the Test is based upon the current syllabi prescribed by the Board of Intermediate Education in Pakistan. The English Language section tests competency in English, as English is the medium of instruction at TIP.
- Applicants must be able to demonstrate competence in English comprehension and expression, both written and verbal.
- Candidates applying for the BSc (Hons) in Design Technology and BBA (Hons) in Fashion design Management Programmes must show some inclination towards arts and design. Applicants must demonstrate their drawing skills in the aptitude test.
- Only candidates successful in the admission test will be called for an interview.
- The interview will strictly be conducted in English.

General Instructions for Candidates

1. Candidates shall not bring any stationery item.
2. Use of calculator is not allowed.
3. The test is divided into 3 parts. Each part consists of many short items.
4. Any evidence of cheating or non-compliance with instructions will disqualify you from the test.
5. In order to select your appropriate choice, **please circle (A), (B), (C) or (D)**. Only one letter representing the answer should be circled. In case more than one letters are circled, the answer will be treated as incorrect.
6. A blank sheet will be provided for rough work which must be returned with the answer sheet.
7. **You must not write any thing anywhere on the test booklet. All answers must be given on the answer sheet.**
8. Candidates **should not** bring mobile phones to the examination hall.

1. In the design section, all answers must be given on the question paper.
2. A separate drawing test will be conducted either before or after the written test.
3. Drawing boards, drawing sheets and basic stationery will be provided by the institute.
